



In September 2021, the Sask Games Council implemented a COVID-19 vaccination requirement and an indoor masking policy to attend the 2022 Sask Winter Games. Since that time, the impact of the pandemic has changed and all public health orders in the province have been lifted and the Federal Government has removed all travel requirements related to COVID-19 within and entering Canada.

The Sask Games Council has consulted with its stakeholders (Districts, Host Organization, Provincial Sport Organizations) and other experts including the Local Health Authority and legal. With this information, the Sask Games Council Board of Directors met this past weekend to review these policies. The following were approved by the Board:

- **To remove the mandatory COVID-19 full vaccination requirement for all Games participants and attendees.**
- **To remove the indoor masking requirement for all participants.** *Note: The Regina Host Organization Medical Division will be empowered to manage masking and depending on the situation could require masking in certain areas (i.e., Poly Clinic).*

We will be working to update all of our previous FAQ information on our website in the next day or so. Please ensure that this information is communicated as your sport or organization starts to work through its selection process.
